Sealed Glove Box Doors (Model GD-1 and GD-2) Installation Instructions

Congratulations on the purchase of your Lockable GD-1 or Non-Lockable GD-2 Sealed Glove Box Doors. This product will give you more storage options and added convenience on your Electra Glide equipped with lower fairing glove boxes. The installation is straightforward and easy. Inventory: The kit includes the following:

1.
 - A. right lockable door/frame assembly (1)
 - B. left sealed door/frame assembly (1)
 - C. allen machine screws, washers, lock washers and nuts (8 each)
 - D. barrel keys (4, if GD-1 option)
 - E. allen wrench (not shown)
 - F. Installation instructions



Caution:

Make sure to wear proper eye protection during the installation!

Glove Box Snap Removal:

2. Remove the stock right side snap-on glove box door and remove the security tether by pushing the cord through the retaining hole. Using an 1 1/64" or 3/16" drill bit, drill out each of the four replaceable plastic snaps from the glove box by positioning the drill bit in the center of each snap. (This will be very easy as the snaps are plastic push inserts and can be replaced later if needed.)

Lockable Glove Box Door Installation:

3. Unlock and open the right lockable door assembly and position it on the glove box in the door opening and align the four holes. Insert 4 machine screws. Inside the glove box, attach a washer, lock washer and nut for each screw. Tighten each nut securely.

4. Check free movement of the sealed glove box door. For GD-1 insert a key and check the locked and unlocked positions. For GD-2, turn the knob and check the open and closed positions.

Notes:

- To Unlock or Open: For GD-1 insert the key then push the key slightly as you turn the key clockwise to unlock. The key will stay in the lock when the lock is in the unlocked position. For GD-2, turn the knob clockwise.
 - To Lock or Close: For GD-1 push the key slightly as you turn the key counter-clockwise to lock. Remove the key. For GD-2, turn the knob counter clockwise.
 - If the doors close too tightly or not tightly enough, you can fine tune this by making small adjustments in the bend of the lock latch arm at the back of the door. Your latch arms have been set at the factory.
 - The GD-1 kit includes four identical keys. One key each for the rider and passenger and two spares. (A good idea is to keep one spare in the Tour-Pak or saddlebag.)
5. Repeat steps 2 through 4 for the left glove box.
 6. Remember to fill out and return your warranty registration and questionnaire card and mail to eGlideGoodies.

Caution!

You should not ride the motorcycle while opening, using or closing the glove box with sealed doors! You should safely pull off the road and come to a complete stop at a location away from moving traffic prior to use.
